What is a SELPA?



The Sonoma County SELPA (Special Education Local Plan Area) believes that all students can learn. Our mission is to support special education students in achieving a high level of academic/functional performance according to national, state, and local standards. To assure this outcome, the SELPA will provide information, resources and support to students, parents, and school staff.



Why does the Sonoma CAC Exist?

The Sonoma Community Advisory Committee serves as a forum to actively participate in the delivery of special education in Sonoma County by:

- Providing parents, educators, community members, and organizations with resources and information regarding the needs of students enrolled in special education.
- Improving communication and collaboration within the local school districts in Sonoma County, to positively impact students; and
- Advising the Sonoma County SELPA's Operational Steering Committee regarding special education issues.

What is the purpose of Sonoma CAC?

The CAC's ultimate goal is to ensure that our students succeed in maximizing their potential, receive the best possible education, and have equal access to all services. The CAC collaborates with the local SELPA to ensure that the educational requirements of special education students are met. We serve as a liaison between SELPA and the Sonoma County Office of Education (SCOE), local districts, families, community, students and teachers, so all voices are heard. We also provide parent education, information and a resource information base.
